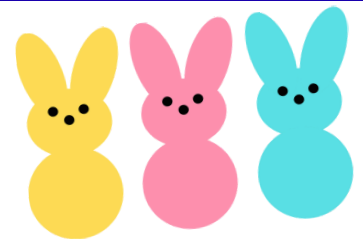

Our summer pitch-in will be Saturday, May 30 at Rice Island in Corydon. Look for more information in next month's newsletter.

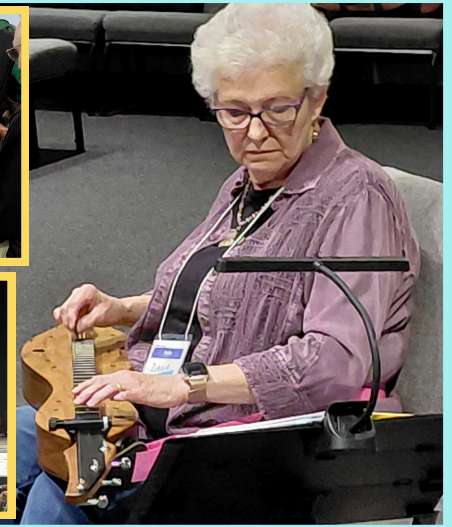
