CDS Annual Picnic

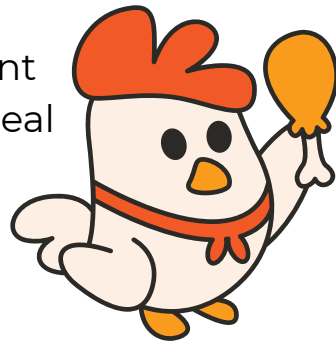
